

# Danzan-Ryū Jūjutsu Japanese Vocabulary

## 檀山流柔術の日本語々彙

The following table is a list of Japanese terms found in Danzan-Ryū Jūjutsu. It is designed to help the Jūjutsu student or teacher easily locate the correct definition of the terms in Danzan-Ryū.

### Notes:

- The **Japanese Term** is the Romanization of one or a combination of Kanji (Chinese characters).
- Long vowels are indicated with a macron over the vowel. (e.g.: ō & ū)
- The **Kanji** were generated by the Japanese Word Processor (JWPce 1.50). In some cases, both older and simplified versions are shown.
- The **Nelson Number** refers to the Kanji numbers found in: [The Original Modern Reader's Japanese English Character Dictionary](#) by Andrew Nathaniel Nelson, 1962, Charles E. Tuttle Company. For example, the term "Akushu" is made up of two Kanji that are found in Nelson as Kanji numbers #1963 and #1827.
- The **English Translation** is an accurate representation of the Kanji's (or Kanji combination's) meaning.
- The **Sample Usage** is an example of how the Japanese Term is used in Danzan-Ryū. This is not intended to be a complete listing of all of the Kanji's occurrences in Danzan-Ryū. The Japanese term is shown in **boldface**.
- Certain Japanese words have a different first consonant depending on context. This does not change the meaning of the term. Examples of this are: Shime vs. Jime, Kama vs. Gama, Tori vs. Dori, etc.
